HISTORY OF OUR INSTITUTE

The Institute of Applied Linguistics (ILA) was approved by the Governing Council on the 17/12/12 and certified by the Regional Government of Andalusia on the 30/06/14 as the first official university institute in Andalusia, after obtaining an evaluation of excellence. It is conceived as a higher education institution, aimed at research, training, transfer and services related to language, capable of formalizing different lines of work of technical-scientific, social, economic and business interest.

Officially constituted on the 19/11/14, it is mainly promoted by the *Semaínein* group, an interuniversity team of excellence of PAIDI, whose national and international prestige is endorsed by the realization of relevant research projects and numerous publications that have been very positively evaluated in external evaluation processes. It has been obtaining, since its founding, a score of excellence in successive PAIDI evaluations (32 points in the 2018 call), establishing itself as the best group of the University of Cadiz.

This work has been recognized with the Award for the Best Group in the field of Humanities and Social and Legal Sciences of the University of Cadiz (1st ed. UCA Research Awards) and the Award for the best scientific contribution in the field of Humanities and Social Sciences (for the monograph *Semántica léxica*, published in RILCE, Q1 on FECYT). In knowledge transfer, it has received several first prizes for the *Tecling* and *Consultoría lingüística* projects, the atrÉBT! Award and, above all, the 2014 HUMAN Award for the transfer and results of research to the business sector, for its numerous R&D projects and contracts.

The ILA also counts with the participation of professors from other groups, departments and institutions, which has led to a remarkable optimization of resources within the UCA itself, and the relevant collaboration of numerous national and international experts, who, as researchers of excellence, have acted as guarantors and external advisors.

Its strategic lines of action are distributed into four specific offices focused on linguistic consultancy and advice, clinical linguistics, forensic linguistics and language technologies and industries, and two transversal laboratories: one for phonetics and the other for computational linguistics. In addition, it has several Peripheral Research Services, as well as two Approved Technical Services for Linguistic Consultancy and Linguistic Expertise. On the other hand, it has framework and specific agreements with different research institutes, scientific organizations and companies. Since its creation, in addition to a series of international, national and regional projects for research and the provision of infrastructure and equipment, it has obtained eighteen positions for Technical Support Staff to strengthen research and transfer work.



• **Digitalisation**: top quality digitalisation of all kinds of documents using a state-of-the-art high-resolution Zenith scanner.




• Language consultancy: correction of texts in Spanish and English, preparation and design of presentations for talks, lectures and symposiums.


- Forensic reports: expert opinion and analysis of spoken and written texts that may be needed in judicial procedures.

 Phonetics and Acoustic Engineering Laboratory: Equipped with acoustic chambers (semianechoic and reverberant) for testing and characterization of sound pressure sources (sound pressure level, sound power level, acoustic energy and directivity) and microphones, in accordance with verification criteria of the UNE-EN ISO 3745 standard for a cut-off frequency of 80Hz.



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
